## THE MEMORY GAME

The Memory Game is a card game that you can play by yourself or with your friends. The aim of the game is to try to collect as many Stories for My Little Sister cards as possible. To win, though, you'll need to remember where they are! Find out how to play the Memory Game below.

## How to play the Memory Game

- 1. To play the Memory Game, you will first need to make your very own Stories for My Little Sister cards. If you have not done this yet, instructions are available at:
  - www.storiesformylittlesister.com/extras/card-games/playing-cards-instructions.pdf
- 2. Now you have your cards, shuffle the deck well.
- 3. Next, lay out the cards face down in a neat pattern, for example, in four rows of eight cards each.
- 4. Now the game begins. The first player turns over two cards. If they are from the same family, then the player collects those cards and has another turn. If they are not from the same family, then they must turn them face down again and try to remember where they are, and give the next player a turn. The player who collects the most pairs wins the game.
- 5. To play by yourself, just keep a note of the number of non-matching pairs that you turn over. The aim is then to collect all the cards in the least number of turns.

If you want to really challenge your memory, why not try to matching four cards at a time instead of two?

You'll need to turn over four cards at a time.
