



How to make a box for your **Stories for My Little Sister** playing cards

1. First, if you haven't got your playing cards yet, you can download instructions on how to make them at:

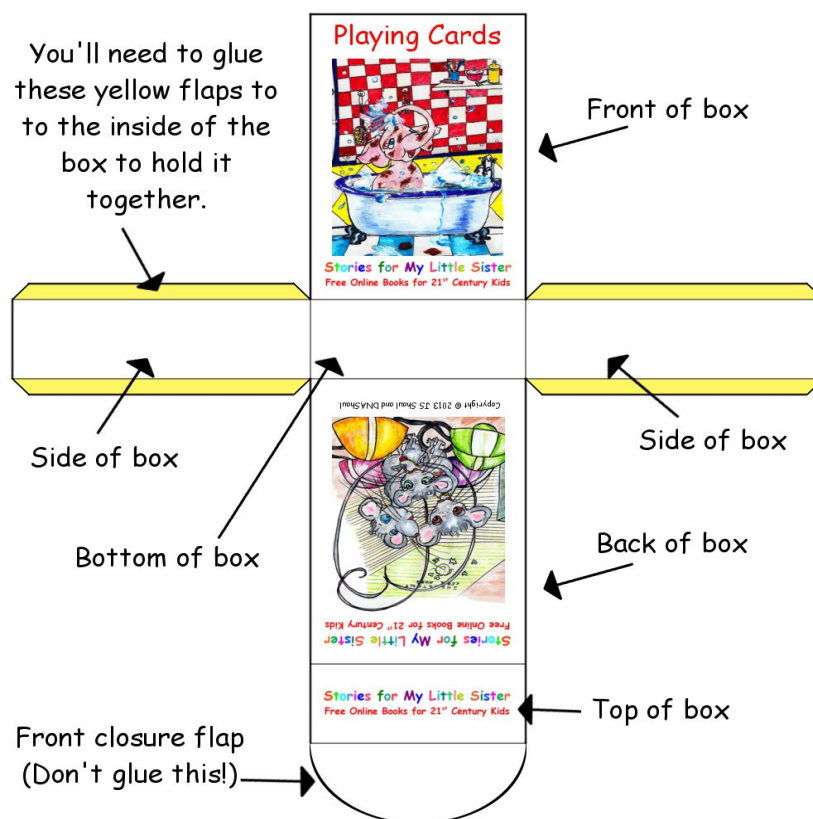

2. Now, to make a box to store them in, start by printing out the following file:

It's best if you can print it out in colour on light card.

3. Next, use a pair of craft scissors to carefully cut along the outline of the box.
4. Now fold along the black lines. Make sure that the sides of the card with the pictures are on the outside of the box.
5. Finally, apply glue along the yellow panels and seal them to the inner sides of the box.
